Feeding Directions

Feed continuously at a rate of not less than 60 mg or more than 300 mg of lasalocid per head per day when on pasture. The drug must be contained in at least 1 pound of feed. Daily intakes of lasalocid in excess of 200 mg/head/day have not been shown to be more effective than 200 mg/head/day.

Feed at a rate to provide at least 60 mg and not more than 360 mg of Lasalocid per head per day. Bring calves on feed gradually and feed according to desired weight gain. Provide a source of fresh, clean water at all times. Do Not Feed wet, moldy or insect infested feed

WARNING: A withdrawal period has not been established for this product in preruminating calves. Do not use in calves to be processed for veal.

WARNING: This product, which contains added copper, should not be fed to sheep or any species that have a low tolerance to copper.
